SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 43

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MRS. ELIZABETH 2 MATTHEWS OF CLINTON, MISSISSIPPI, RECIPIENT OF THE 2004 BLUE CROSS 3 & BLUE SHIELD OF MISSISSIPPI AGELESS HERO AWARD IN THE CATEGORY OF 4 GOOD NEIGHBOR.

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Elizabeth Matthews of Clinton, Mississippi, an 6 87-year-old who helped start the Magnolia Speech School, was 7 recently honored as a recipient of the Blue Cross & Blue Shield of 8 Mississippi Ageless Hero Award, which recognizes those over 65 who 9 demonstrate activity, vitality and accomplishment; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Matthews is the Central Region honoree in the 11 Good Neighbor category. She was one of 400 nominees for the 12 Seventh Annual Program. Judges chose 24 nominees ranging in age 13 from 66 to 106; and

14 WHEREAS, in honor of Mrs. Matthews, Blue Cross will donate 15 \$500 to Magnolia Speech School. Anne Sullivan, Director of 16 Magnolia Speech School, nominated her for the award; and

17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Matthews took steps to become a teacher and 18 started Magnolia Speech School after learning her son, Keith, was 19 deaf. She found the prospect of him leading an isolated life 20 apart from the hearing world to be unacceptable. Magnolia Speech 21 School, which began with seven students in her living room, has 22 become one of the country's leading schools for hearing impaired 23 and language-disordered children; and

24 WHEREAS, after serving as Director from 1956-1974, Elizabeth 25 retired, but has remained involved. She has served as Director 26 Emeritus, volunteered as a Teacher and raised funds for the 27 school. Mrs. Matthews raised \$10,000 in the fall of 2003 for the

28 school and she is also a very active member of Parkway Baptist29 Church in Clinton; and

30 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Matthews has touched the lives of 31 thousands of people over the years, not only the deaf children she 32 educated and helped in so many ways, but also the parents of these 33 children. She is cherished as a friend, as well as an expert in 34 the field of deaf education; and

35 WHEREAS, it is with pride that we recognize the determination 36 of this Ageless Hero, who has contributed so much to her community 37 and to the State of Mississippi:

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 39 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Mrs. 40 Elizabeth Matthews of Clinton, Mississippi, recipient of the 2004 41 Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi Ageless Hero Award in the 42 category of Good Neighbor, and extend to her the best wishes of

43 the Senate on her future endeavors.
