## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

#### MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1107: Hunting and fishing licenses; waive fees for resident who is member of United States Armed Forces, National Guard or Reserves.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:

49-7-3. (1) Any resident of the State of Mississippi shall
be entitled to receive a resident fishing license.

12 (2) Any person domiciled within the State of Mississippi shall be entitled to receive a resident hunting license provided 13 14 in Section 49-7-5. The domicile of a person is that person's 15 principal or primary home or place of abode. A "principal or 16 primary home or place of abode" is that home or place in which a 17 person's habitation is fixed and to which he, whenever absent, has the present intention of returning after a departure of absence 18 19 therefrom, regardless of the duration of the absence. The burden of proving domicile shall be on the person claiming such status. 20 21 The following evidence or other reliable evidence may be 2.2 considered in establishing, but is not necessarily determinative 23 of, domicile: driver's license, residence for income or other tax purposes, homestead exemption receipt, or any other means 2.4 25 prescribed by the department. In the case of minors, domicile of 26 the parents shall be used as evidence of the minor's domicile.

(3) A nondomiciliary of the state may be issued a resident
hunting or fishing license or combination resident hunting/fishing
license upon providing the following:

30 (a) A current identification card from a Mississippi31 college or university; or

32 (b) A current military identification card showing that 33 the person is an active member of the <u>United States</u> Armed Forces 34 (excluding Reserves and the National Guard) and proof that the 35 person is stationed on a military base in Mississippi.

36 (4) <u>A nondomiciliary of the state may be issued a special</u>
37 <u>armed forces fourteen-day hunting and fishing license with the</u>
38 <u>same hunting and fishing privileges and at the same fee of a</u>
39 <u>resident sportsman's license, if the nondomiciliary is an active</u>
40 <u>member of the United States Armed Forces (excluding Reserves and</u>
41 <u>the National Guard) and his application is approved by the</u>

42 department. The applicant must file his application for the

43 special fourteen-day license in the office of the department. The

44 department shall establish requirements for proof of active

45 military status and any other requirements it deems desirable.

46 The department shall not issue more than two (2) special fourteen-

47 day licenses to the same applicant per license year.

48 (5) A holder of a resident or nonresident license is 49 required to carry the license on his person while engaged in 50 hunting, trapping or fishing. Any penalty for not carrying a 51 license while engaged in hunting, trapping or fishing shall be 52 waived if the person can verify purchase of a license prior to the 53 date of the violation.

54 <u>(6)</u> Each application or filing made under this section shall 55 include the social security number(s) of the applicant in 56 accordance with Section 93-11-64 **\* \* \***.

57 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after July 1, 2004.
