REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1698: Appropriation; Pearl River Basin Development District.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out			
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available			
8	to the Pearl River Basin Development District, for the purpose of			
9	defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the			
13	provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 67 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 68 Pearl River Basin Development District shall maintain complete
- 69 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 70 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 71 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 72 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 73 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
- 74 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 75 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 76 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
- 77 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 Director of the Pearl River Basin Development District shall be
- 79 authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source,
- 80 not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), for the
- 81 purpose of maintaining the Lower Pearl Restoration Project in
- 82 accordance with the Project Cooperation Agreement with the United
- 83 States Army Corps of Engineers and to maintain the South Jackson
- 84 Clearing Project in an area along the Pearl River in Hinds County
- 85 and Rankin County, in accordance with rules and regulations of the
- 86 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 87 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 88 **SECTION 5.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
- 89 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which

shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, 90

91 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the

92 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent

(1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills 93

of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer. 94

95 SECTION 6. The money herein approved for expenditure shall

be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 96

97 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with

98 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

99 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2004. 100
