REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1716: Appropriation; Public Employees' Retirement System-administrative expenses; maintenance and operation of building.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of
10	the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of
11	defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of
12	the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building
14	Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose
15	of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System
16	Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
17	June 30, 2005\$ 9,700,900.00.
18	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
20	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
21	expenditure:

38	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
39	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
40	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
41	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
42	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
43	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
44	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
45	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
46	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
47	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
48	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
49	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
50	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
51	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
52	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
53	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
54	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
55	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
56	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
57	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
58	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
59	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

60	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
61	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
62	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
63	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
64	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
65	Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
66	approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
67	without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
68	appropriated level.
69	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
70	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
71	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
72	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
73	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
74	Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall
75	maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
76	expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
77	records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
78	maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of
79	the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
80	2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
81	in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
82	of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request
83	process.
84	SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
85	necessary, while remaining within the project cost of Sixteen
86	Million Four Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-five
87	Dollars (\$16,432,885.00) is hereby reappropriated out of any money
88	in the State Treasury to the credit of the Building Fund Expense
89	Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose
90	of construction and renovation to the existing building and

parking facilities located at 429 Mississippi Street in Jackson,

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92	Mississippi, including architectural fees and furnishings, as well
93	as associated moving expenses and to provide monies for the lease
94	of facilities while the construction/renovation is underway, for
95	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
96	\$3,000,000.00.
97	The expenditure of funds appropriated under this section
98	shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Finance and
99	Administration, and the Department of Finance and Administration
100	shall submit an annual report regarding such expenditures to the
101	Legislative Budget Office, the House Public Buildings, Grounds and
102	Lands Committee and the Senate Public Property Committee.
103	SECTION 5. In accordance with the purposes of this article,
104	there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public
105	Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund,
106	into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income
107	from the building owned by the system located at 301 North
108	President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal
109	year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the
110	Administrative Budget Fund of the system.
111	It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have
112	the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System
113	Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed
114	Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and
115	maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. All
116	expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building
117	Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this
118	article and for the purposes designated herein.
119	SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
120	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
121	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
122	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

123 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

124 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

125 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

126 and after July 1, 2004.
