REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1720: Appropriation; Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 36 37 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 38 39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 40 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 44 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 46 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 47 48 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 49 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 50 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 51 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 53 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 54 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 55 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

56 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 57 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 58 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written

The 60 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 61 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 62 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 63 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 68 69 Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification 70 Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records 71 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this 72 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the 73 74 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 75 76 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 77 78 budget request process.

79 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 80 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 81 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 82 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 83 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 84

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 85

and after July 1, 2004. 86
