## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1722: Appropriation; Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 40 41 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 42 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 43 44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 45 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 46 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 47 48 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 49 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 50 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 51 52 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 53 54 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 55 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 56 57 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"

appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 63 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 64 65 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 66 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 67 68 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 70 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

75 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall maintain 76 77 complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 78 79 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 80 maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of 81 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 82 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 83 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 84 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request 85 process.

86 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 87 agency shall provide a report reflecting Fiscal Year 2004 usage of 88 wireless communication devices which shall include cellular 89 phones, two-way radios, pagers, or any other means of wireless

(H)AP (S)AP A1/2 90 communications to the Chairman of the House Appropriations 91 Committee, the Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, 92 and the State Auditor by September 1, 2004. The report shall 93 contain, but not be limited to, the following:

94 (1) The number of wireless communication devices provided to95 employees by the agency;

96 (2) The annual cost of usage of wireless communication 97 devices by each employee of the agency who is issued a wireless 98 communication device;

99 (3) Separate justification of the usage of wireless 100 communication devices by those employees issued wireless 101 communication devices; and

102 (4) To determine whether quantifiable benefits are 103 associated with the utilization of wireless communications and 104 whether such service provides more efficient or effective service 105 delivery.

SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated out of any funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium, for the purpose of preventing a deficit, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004.....\$ 75,000.00.

**SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
