## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1734: Appropriation; Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Governor's Office
10	- Division of Medicaid for the purpose of providing medical
11	assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law and defraying the
12	expenses of the administration of such law, as provided in Section
13	43-13-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year
14	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
15	\$ 247,025,158.00.
16	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
17	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
18	Treasury to the credit of the Medical Care Fund created by Section
19	43-13-143, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of providing
20	medical assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law for the
21	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
22	\$ 280,014,150.00.
23	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
24	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
25	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office
26	- Division of Medicaid which is comprised of special source funds
27	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the

28	purpose of providing medical assistance under the Mississippi
29	Medicaid Law and defraying the expenses of the administration of
30	such law, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
31	June 30, 2005\$ 3,191,184,287.00.
32	Prior period recovery of funds may be maintained and expended
33	by the division when the recovery is received or finalized.
34	SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
35	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
36	Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the
37	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Governor's Office -
38	Division of Medicaid for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004,
39	and ending June 30, 2005 \$ 167,273,753.00.
40	The above funds shall be allocated as follows:
41	CHIP Program at 200% level of poverty\$ 6,214,717.00
42	Eyeglasses for adults\$ 1,509,288.00
43	Home and Community Waiver Program\$ 4,257,081.00
44	Disabled worker buy-in to the Medicaid

48	Medical Services Program Matching Funds.\$151,443,981.00
49	It is the intention of the Legislature that funds may be
50	shifted among the above allocated line items where needed in the
51	discretion of the Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid.
52	SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
53	Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, not more than the amounts set forth below
54	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

76	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
77	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
78	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
79	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
80	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
81	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
82	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
83	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
84	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
85	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
86	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
87	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
88	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
89	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
90	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
91	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency

92 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 93 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 94 95 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 96 97 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 98 99 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 100 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. 101 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 102 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 103 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 104 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 105 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 106 appropriated level. 107 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 108 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 109 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 110 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 111 112 Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete 113 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 114 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 115 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 116 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 117 118 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 119 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

145	objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar

147	SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
148	Section 3, Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) shall be derived
149	from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,
150	Mississippi Code of 1972.
151	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that an
152	amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)
153	appropriated in this act may be used to realign existing

154 positions.

SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004.
