## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1739: Appropriation; Department of Archives and History.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
б	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
10	June 30, 2005\$ 8,242,801.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
14	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds
15	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
18	\$ 3,614,131.00.
19	SECTION 3. With funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

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With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 26 27 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 28 29 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 30 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 31 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 33 34 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 35 36 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 37 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 38 39 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 40 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 41 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 42 43 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 44 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 45 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 46 47 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

48 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 49 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 50 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 51 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 52 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 53 54 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 55 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 56 appropriated level.

The agency shall not take any action to award salary
increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment,
education benchmark or career ladder.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 64 SECTION 4. 65 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 66 67 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 68 69 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 70 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 71 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 72 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 73

74 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 75 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, 76 donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 77 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 78 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 79 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 80 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 81 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

82 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 83 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 84 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 85 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 86 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 87 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 88 Archives and History.

159 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 160 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept, 161 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to 162 163 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section 27-19-56.69 (8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of 164 165 paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance 166 167 and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 168 federal funds.

SECTION 11. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00)is provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

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179 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

180 **SECTION 13.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 181 and after July 1, 2004.
