REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1742: Appropriation; Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State б 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the Grand Gulf Military Monument 9 Commission in the operation and maintenance of the Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and 10 11 ending June 30, 2005\$ 217,885.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Grand Gulf 14 Military Monument Commission, for the purpose of defraying the 15 expenses of the commission in the operation and maintenance of the 16 17 Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning 18 July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005.....\$ 146,661.00. 19 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 2.0 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 21 22 expenditure: 23 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: Personal Services: 2.4 25 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits .. \$ 218,881.00

48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
53	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
54	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
55	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
56	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.

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- 58 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
- 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 63 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 67 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 69 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 73 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 75 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 76 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 77 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 78 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 79 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete
- 80 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 81 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 82 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 83 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 84 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
- 85 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 86 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 87 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
- 88 **SECTION 5.** It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or
- 89 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of

any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 90 91 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 92 93 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof. It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 94 95 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 96 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. 97 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 100 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 102 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 103 and after July 1, 2004. 104
