## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1746: Appropriation; State Fire Academy.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy Fund, for the		
7	purpose of defraying the expenses of the academy for the fiscal		
8	year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005		
9	\$ 4,074,045.00.		
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be		
12	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of		
13	expenditure:

- 59 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 62 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 63 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 64 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 65 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 66 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and
- 67 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 68 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 69 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 70 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 71 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to
- 72 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 73 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 74 during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
- 75 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 76 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend
- 77 funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 78 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the
- 79 agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 80 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 81 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 82 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 83 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 84 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 85 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 86 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 87

88 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

89 and after July 1, 2004.
