H. B. No. 1805: City of Charleston; authorize to lease land to Robert Hill Youth Foundation, Inc.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the City of					
б	Charleston, Mississippi, in their discretion, may lease up to					
7	fifteen (15) acres of land owned or leased by the city to the					
8	Robert Hill Youth Foundation, Incorporated, for a period of up to					
9	twenty (20) years under such terms, conditions and consideration					
10	as the governing authorities of Charleston, in their discretion,					
11	deem will best promote the educational, cultural, social or					
12	economic welfare of the city.					

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 14 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CHARLESTON, MISSISSIPPI, TO 2 LEASE UP TO 15 ACRES OF LAND OWNED OR LEASED BY THE CITY TO THE 3 ROBERT HILL YOUTH FOUNDATION, INC.; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
