REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2896: Wildlife; authorize seizure of wild hogs imported into the state.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-140, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 49-7-140. (1) No person may import into the state, or
- 11 release into the wild, any live feral hog, wild swine or Russian
- 12 Boar.
- 13 (2) Any feral hog, wild swine or Russian Boar imported into
- 14 the state shall be seized by the department for disposal or
- destruction.
- 16 (3) For the purposes of this section, "feral hogs, wild
- 17 swine, or Russian Boar" are defined as any hog that is not a
- 18 domesticated pet or livestock; and "released into the wild" is
- 19 defined as being able to move about freely to adjoining land.
- 20 (4) A violation of this section is a Class I violation
- 21 punishable as provided in Section 49-7-141.
- SECTION 2. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 23 amended as follows:
- 49-7-33. (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild
- 25 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
- 26 of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of
- 27 calls of any kind, except a person may use electrically amplified
- 28 sound devices for hunting coyote and crow. The commission, in its

- 29 discretion, may relax the restrictions regarding the use of lures
- 30 or sound devices if a condition arises or exists, as decided by
- 31 the State Board of Health or county board of health, that may
- 32 endanger persons or livestock in a certain community, county or
- 33 area.
- 34 (2) A person may use liquid scents for any animal or bird.
- 35 (3) A person may use the attractants prohibited under this
- 36 section to trap wild hogs, as defined in Section 49-7-140, on
- 37 private lands during the period between the end of spring turkey
- 38 season and September 30. A person must obtain a special
- 39 depredation permit from the department before trapping wild hogs
- 40 under this section. The department shall not charge a fee for the
- 41 special depredation permit.
- 42 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-140, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR THE SEIZURE OF FERAL HOGS, WILD SWINE AND RUSSIAN BOARS IMPORTED INTO THE STATE; TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE TRAPPING OF WILD HOGS WHEN THERE IS NO OPEN SEASON ON DEER AND TURKEY; AND FOR RELATED
