REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3111: Appropriation; Treasurers Office.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
5	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
6	State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
7	expenses of the office of the State Treasurer for the fiscal year
8	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
9	\$ 582,785.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the special
12	fund entitled Abandoned Property Fund in the State Treasury for
13	the purpose of defraying expenses of the State Treasurer in
14	administering the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property and
15	certain other expenses of the office, for the fiscal year
16	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
17	\$ 2,362,358.00.
18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:
20	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
21	Permanent: Full Time 33
22	Part Time 0
23	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
24	Part Time 0

25	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
26	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
27	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
28	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
29	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
30	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
31	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
32	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
33	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
34	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
35	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
36	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
37	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
38	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
39	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
40	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
41	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
42	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
43	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
44	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
45	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
46	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
47	The agency shall not award salary increases through
48	reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark,
49	or career ladder.
50	SECTION 4. In addition to all other sums herein
51	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
52	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
53	Treasury to the credit of the Education Improvement Trust Fund No.
54	3219 for the purpose of investing funds for the fiscal year
55	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
56	\$ 125,000.00.

57	SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
58	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
59	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable
60	College Tuition Administrative Fund to defray the costs of the
61	Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Program for the
62	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
63	\$ 1,493,301.00.
64	With the funds appropriated in this section, the following
65	positions are authorized:
66	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
67	Permanent: Full Time 5
68	It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
69	Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend an
70	amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
71	(\$250,000.00) from administrative fees charged and from interest
72	earnings on any funds authorized for administration of the
73	Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Program, for the
74	administration of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College
75	Tuition Program. Such funds shall be escalated in accordance with
76	the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
77	Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
78	federal funds.
79	SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
80	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
81	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable
82	College Tuition Trust Fund for the purpose of paying all amounts
83	due for prepaid tuition contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid
84	Affordable College Tuition Program, for the fiscal year beginning
85	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005\$ 8,500,000.00.
86	It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
87	Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend an
88	amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from any

89	funds authorized for the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College
90	Tuition Program, for paying amounts due for prepaid tuition
91	contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition
92	Program. Such funds shall be escalated in accordance with the
93	rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
94	Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
95	federal funds.
96	SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
97	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
98	Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, created
99	under House Bill No. 519, 1999 Regular Session, for the purpose of
100	defraying the expenses of the Office of the State Treasurer for
101	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
102	June 30, 2005\$ 107,429.00.
103	With the funds appropriated in this section, the following
104	positions are authorized:
105	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
106	Permanent: Full Time 2
107	SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
108	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
109	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Affordable College
110	Savings Administrative Fund to defray the costs of the Mississippi
111	Affordable College Savings Program for the fiscal year beginning
112	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005\$ 297,313.00.
113	With the funds appropriated in this section, the following
114	positions are authorized:
115	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
116	Permanent: Full Time 2
117	It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
118	Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend an
119	amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)
120	from any funds deposited into the Mississippi Affordable College

122 investment earnings received by the Mississippi Affordable College Savings Program. Such funds shall be escalated in accordance with 123 124 the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 125 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 126 federal funds. 127 SECTION 9. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of said 128 129 funds be used either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of paying any clerk, stenographer, assistant, deputy or other person 130 131 who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree, 132 computed by the rules of the civil law, to the official employing 133 or having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the 134 event of any such payment, then the official or person approving and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and 135 136 severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or 137 138 received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General; provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person 139 140 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this 141 provision shall not apply. SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 142 143 Office of the State Treasurer shall maintain complete accounting 144 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 145 appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such 146 records shall be in the same format and level of details as 147 maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall 148 149 be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 150 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 151

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SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2004.
