REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3123: Appropriation; Gaming Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
19	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below

42 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 44 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 45 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 46 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the 47 48 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 49 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 50 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 54 55 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 57 58 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this

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59 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 60 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 61 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 62 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 66 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 68 The 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 70 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

77 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 78 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be 79 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a 80 nonprofit organization.

81 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 82 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 83 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 86

87 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88 and after July 1, 2004.
