REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3132: Appropriation; Animal Health Board.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of		
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Board of Animal Health		
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
12	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special		
13	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available		
14	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Board		
15	of Animal Health, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and		
16	ending June 30, 2005\$ 454,419.00.		
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
18	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall		
19	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of		
20	expenditure:

- 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 61 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 62 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 66 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 68 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 69 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 70 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 71 appropriated level.
- 72 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 73 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 74 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 75 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 76 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 Executive Director of the Mississippi Board of Animal Health may
- 78 authorize increases in other objects of expenditure in total
- 79 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the
- 80 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided
- 81 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
- 82 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be
- 83 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
- 84 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."
- 85 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 86 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 87 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 88 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 89 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 90 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 91

92 and after July 1, 2004.
