 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

135	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
136	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to
137	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
138	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
139	during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
140	SECTION 11. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by
141	this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be
142	paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or
143	funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State
144	Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
145	warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
146	officers in the manner provided by law.
147	SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
148	and after July 1, 2004.
