REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3143: Appropriation; Veterans Affairs Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs
8	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
9	June 30, 2005\$ 1,355,025.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
12	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs
13	Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
14	otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance
15	of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and
16	ending June 30, 2005\$ 26,822,997.00.
17	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
18	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:
19	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
20	Permanent: Full Time 80
21	Part Time 0
22	Time-Limited: Full Time 620
23	Part Time 100
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
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- 26 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 27 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
- 28 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
- 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
- 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 34 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 39 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 41 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
- 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 49 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 51 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 52 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 54 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

- 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not award salary increases through
- 60 reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark,
- 61 or career ladder.
- 62 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 63 Sections 1 and 2, funds in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty
- 64 Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of
- 65 providing care to indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the
- 66 non-veteran surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the
- 67 surviving spouse was a resident of a state veterans home at the
- 68 time of the veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's
- 69 death, meets the indigent/low-income criteria established by the
- 70 State Veterans Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is
- 71 the intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to
- 72 use of indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for
- 73 any such period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a
- 74 current surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section
- 75 and its provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R.
- 76 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997."
- 77 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 78 Section 2, Six Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-
- 79 two Dollars (\$621,472.00) shall be derived from the Health Care
- 80 Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of
- 81 1972, for the support and maintenance of the Veterans' Affairs
- 82 Board.
- 83 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 84 Veterans Affairs Board shall maintain complete accounting and
- 85 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 86 appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such
- 87 records shall be in the same format and level of details as
- 88 maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of

the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall 89 90 be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 91 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 92 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 93 94 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 95 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 96 97 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 98 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 99 100 and after July 1, 2004.
