House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2599

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) Any pre-need contract which is executed by
- 8 the decedent for his own arrangements and is fully funded
- 9 overrules, following the decedent's death, the conflicting wishes
- 10 of the decedent's next of kin, unless a compelling public interest
- 11 makes it impossible to comply with a decedent's directions in a
- 12 pre-need contract.
- 13 (2) The provisions of this section shall not prevent the
- 14 decedent's next of kin or surviving heirs at law from, at their
- 15 own expense, pursuing reasonable services and making reasonable
- 16 arrangements that do not conflict with the decedent's directions
- 17 in a pre-need contract.
- 18 (3) All contract providers shall have the right to rely on
- 19 the pre-need contract and perform obligations in accordance with
- 20 the pre-need contract. There shall be no liability for any
- 21 contract provider who in good faith performs his obligations
- 22 pursuant to the pre-need contract, provided the pre-need contract
- 23 is in compliance with Section 75-63-51 et seq. and any rules
- 24 promulgated thereunder.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2004.
