House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2869

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 Section 97-3-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 97-3-37. (1) For purposes of the offenses enumerated in 9 this subsection (1), the term "human being" includes an unborn 10 child at every stage of gestation from conception until live birth 11 12 and the term "unborn child" means a member of the species homo sapiens, at any stage of development, who is carried in the womb: 13 (a) Section 97-3-7, simple and aggravated assault and 14 15 domestic violence; 16 (b) Section 97-3-15, justifiable homicide; (c) Section 97-3-17, excusable homicide; 17 (d) Section 97-3-19, capital murder; 18 19 (e) Section 97-3-27, homicide while committing a 20 felony; 21 (f) Section 97-3-29, homicide while committing a misdemeanor; 22 (g) Section 97-3-33, killing a trespasser 23 24 unnecessarily; (h) Section 97-3-35, killing without malice in the heat 25 26 of passion; 27 (i) Section 97-3-45, homicide by means of a dangerous 28 animal; (j) Section 97-3-47, all other homicides; 29 30 (k) Section 97-3-61, poisoning with intent to kill or 31 injure.

- 32 (2) A person who intentionally injures a pregnant woman is
- 33 guilty of a crime as follows:
- 34 (a) If the conduct results in a miscarriage or
- 35 stillbirth by that individual, a felony punishable by imprisonment
- 36 for not more than twenty (20) years or a fine of not more than
- 37 Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00), or both.
- 38 (b) If the conduct results in great bodily harm to the
- 39 embryo or fetus, a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 40 than twenty (20) years or a fine of not more than Five Thousand
- 41 Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.
- 42 (c) If the conduct results in serious or aggravated
- 43 physical injury to the embryo or fetus, a misdemeanor punishable
- 44 by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year or a fine of not
- 45 more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.
- 46 (d) If the conduct results in physical injury to the
- 47 embryo or fetus, a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not
- 48 more than ninety (90) days or a fine of not more than Five Hundred
- 49 Dollars (\$500.00), or both.
- 50 (3) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any
- 51 legal medical procedure performed by a licensed physician or other
- 52 licensed medical professional, including legal abortions, when
- 53 done at the request of a mother of an unborn child or the mother's
- 54 legal guardian, or to the lawful dispensing or administration of
- 55 lawfully prescribed medication.
- 56 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after July 1, 2004.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-3-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE OFFENSES OF ASSAULT AND HOMICIDE SO AS TO INCLUDE AN

3 UNBORN CHILD AT EVERY STATE OF GESTATION FROM CONCEPTION UNTIL

4 LIVE BIRTH WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF "HUMAN BEING"; TO DEFINE THE 5 TERM "UNBORN CHILD"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
