## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3105

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

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Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Ethics Commission for
8	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
9	\$ 519,418.00.
10	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
11	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
12	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
13	Permanent: Full Time 8
14	Part Time0
15	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
16	Part Time0
17	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
18	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
19	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
20	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
21	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
22	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
23	SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
24	all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:
25	(1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
26	positions;
27	(2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or
28	otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,
29	reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,

- 30 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- 31 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 32
- 33 The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
- travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 34
- 35 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 36 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 37 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 38 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology 39
- 40 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 41
- The agency shall not expend funds to publish or 42 (5)
- distribute any annual reports or other publications; 43
- 44 The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- 45 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 46
- 47 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 48 The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 49 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- 50 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 51 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 52 The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
- 53 or training services;
- 54 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease 55
- 56 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
- 57 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
- forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session. 58
- 59 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 60
- 61 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate
- are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 62
- 63 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public
- 64 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening

of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 65

66 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or

any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 67

68 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the

Mississippi State Legislature." 69

70 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

71 Mississippi Ethics Commission shall maintain complete accounting

72 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

73 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 74

75 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to 76

the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

78 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided

during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 79

80 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 81

82 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

83 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 84

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 85

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 86

87 and after July 1, 2004.
