House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3107

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

19	9 counties as provided by Section 7-7	7-201 et seq., Mississippi Code

22	2 SECTION 3. Of the funds appro	priated under the provisions of

29	9 With the funds herein appropri	ated, it is the intention of
30	0 the Legislature that it shall be th	ne agency's responsibility to

- 31 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
- 32 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
- funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 33
- 34 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
- 35 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 36 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 37
- 38 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 39 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 40
- 41 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 42
- 43 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 44

- SECTION 4. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 64

- 69 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,
- 70 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- 71 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- 72 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 73 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 74 The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
- travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 75
- 76 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 77 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 78 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 79 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology 80
- 81 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 82
- 83 The agency shall not expend funds to publish or (5)
- 84 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- The agency shall not expend funds for public relation 85
- 86 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- 87 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 88 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 89 The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 90 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 91
- 92 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 93 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
- 94 or training services;
- 95 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease 96
- 97 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
- appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set 98
- forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session. 99

100	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none	
101	of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members	
102	of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate	
103	are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony	
104	announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public	
105	announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening	
106	of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has	
107	made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or	
108	any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following	
109	language: "Funds were made available for this project by the	
110	Mississippi State Legislature."	
111	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the	
112	State Department of Audit shall maintain complete accounting and	
113	personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds	
114	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the	
115	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year	
116	2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the	
117	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to	
118	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of	
119	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided	
120	during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.	
121	SECTION 7. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance	
122	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of	
123	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized	
124	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the	
125	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,	
126	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted	
127	performance measures provided below:

146	SECTION 8. In addition to the sums appropriated herein, the	
147	Office of the State Auditor is hereby authorized to receive,	
148	budget, and expend, with the approval of the Department of Finance	
149	and Administration, any special funds made available to comply	
150	with the Single Audit Act of 1984. These special funds may be	
151	used to employ staff, reallocate existing staff, and pay related	
152	expenses, or to engage private accountants, as necessary, to	
153	comply with the provisions of the Act.	
154	SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by	
155	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the	
156	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon	
157	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal	
158	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the	
159	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.	
160	SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from	
161	and after July 1, 2004.
