House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3126

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as		
5	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the		
6	State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the		
7	expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal		
8	year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005		
9	\$ 18,149,533.00.		
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
12	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or		
13	the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the		
14	expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the		
15	authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending		
16	June 30, 2005\$ 148,455,431.00.		
17	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions		
18	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

20	Permanent: Full Time 295		
21	Part Time 2		
22	Time-Limited: Full Time 24		
23	Part Time 1		
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of		
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to		
26	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal		
27	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005		
28	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions		
29	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the

- 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 32
- 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 34
- 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 39
- 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 41
- 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 43
- 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 46
- 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 49
- 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 51 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 52 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 54 appropriated level.
- 55 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 57

- 59 SECTION 4. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
- all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions: 60
- 61 The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant (1)

- 63 The agency shall not take any action to promote or
- 64 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,

- 65 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- 66 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 67
- 68 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state 69 (3)
- 70 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 71
- 72 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 73 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the 74
- 75 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- 76 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 77 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 78 The agency shall not expend funds to publish or
- 79 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- 80 The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the 81
- 82 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 83 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 84 (7)
- 85 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- 86 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 87 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 88 The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
- 89 or training services;
- 90 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- 91 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
- purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this 92
- 93 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
- 94 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.
- SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 95
- 96 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members
- of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 97
- are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 98
- 99 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public

100	announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening		
101	of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has		
102	made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or		
103	any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following		
104	language: "Funds were made available for this project by the		
105	Mississippi State Legislature."		
106	SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance		
107	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of		
108	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized		
109	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the		
110	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,		
111	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted		
112	performance measures provided below:

153	SECTION 8. The acceptance and expenditure of fu	nds, and	
154	interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or		
155	other orders of or agreements involving any agency,		
156	instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or	the United	
157	States for petroleum price compliance and allocation	which may	
158	become available during the fiscal year for the suppo	rt of the	
159	Mississippi Development Authority or any programs spo	nsored under	
160	the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby au	thorized not	
161	to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and app	roved,	
162	provided such receipts and expenditures are reported	and otherwise	
163	accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 e	t seq., and	
164	Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.		
165	SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislatu	re that the	
166	Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorize	d to	
167	escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not	to exceed	
168	Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance wi	th rules and	

- 169 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 170 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 171
- 172 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete
- accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 173
- 174 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 175
- Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 176
- 177 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
- submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 178
- 179 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 180
- SECTION 11. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 181
- 182 the amount of Six Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars
- 183 (\$6,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 184 provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism
- Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2005. The expenditure 185
- 186 of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section
- 187 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 188
- the amount of One Million Five Hundred Sixty-seven Thousand 189
- Dollars (\$1,567,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, 190
- 191 is provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and
- 192 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2005.
- 193 The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be
- exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972. 194
- SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein 195
- appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 196
- 197 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 198 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
- Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for 199
- 200 Mississippi Technology Alliance, for the fiscal year beginning
- July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 \$1,250,000.00. 201
- The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 202
- 203 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for

- 204 support of Mississippi Technology Alliance to strengthen the
- 205 business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and
- growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more 206
- 207 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi
- 208 economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
- 209 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
- 210 Development Authority.
- 211 SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein
- 212 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 213
- 214 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
- Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to 215
- 216 support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce
- Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending 217
- 218 June 30, 2005.....\$ 728,398.00.
- 219 The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
- apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi 220
- 221 Development Authority.
- 222 SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- of Section 2, Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) shall be 223
- 224 derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-
- 225 103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 226 SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 227 of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2
- 228 shall be expended for the purpose of supporting an annual event
- known as the Mississippi Picnic which has traditionally been held 229
- 230 in New York, New York, at Central Park.
- SECTION 17. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 231
- 232 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 233 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 234
- 235 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 236
- SECTION 18. This act shall take effect and be in force from 237
- and after July 1, 2004. 238
