House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3130

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as |

B. 3130 PAGE 1 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;

37 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or38 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

39 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation 40 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the 41 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 42 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;

(7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

47 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development48 or training services;

(9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.

54 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 55 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 56 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 57 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 58 59 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 60 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 61 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 62 63 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 64 Mississippi State Legislature."

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 Mississippi Egg Marketing Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 67 68 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 69 70 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to 71 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 72 73 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 74

75 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 76 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 77 78 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 79 80 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 82 and after July 1, 2004.
