## **House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3131**

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

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Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central
8	Market, to defray the expenses of said Farmers Central Market and
9	to provide for the payment of any indebtedness which may accrue
10	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
11	June 30, 2005\$ 313,280.00
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 6
16	Part Time 0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
18	Part Time0
19	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
20	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
21	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
22	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
23	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
24	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
25	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
26	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
27	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
28	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
29	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
30	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual

- 31 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- 32 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 33
- 34 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 35
- 36 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
- appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 37
- 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 40
- 41 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 42 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 43
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 44
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 47
- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 50
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 54 Provided, however, that all funds received from any and all
- sources shall be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury 55
- to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market. 56
- SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 57
- all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions: 58
- 59 (1)The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
- 60 positions;
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or 61
- otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, 62
- reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 63
- 64 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions

- 65 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 66 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state 67
- 68 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 69
- 70 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 71 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 72 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- 73 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 74
- 75 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 76 The agency shall not expend funds to publish or (5)
- 77 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- 78 The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- 79 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- 80 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 81
- 82 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 83 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 84
- 85 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 86 The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
- 87 or training services;
- 88 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- 89 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
- purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this 90
- 91 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
- forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session. 92
- It is the intention of the Legislature that none 93 SECTION 4.
- 94 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members
- of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 95
- 96 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony
- announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 97
- 98 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening
- 99 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has

100 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or

101 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

102 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the

103 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Farmers Central Market shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 

provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

SECTION 6. The board shall promulgate and adopt reasonable rules and regulations, including employing attendants, to regulate and provide for the parking of motor vehicles at the farm produce marketing facility near the Mississippi Memorial Stadium for regularly scheduled football games, and said board shall make said facility available for such purpose and shall make a reasonable charge therefor comparable to the charge made for parking in the area contiguous to the stadium. The net proceeds from such parking shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market and shall be used solely for general maintenance and repair of the Central Market

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
