House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3134

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
7	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
8	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission
9	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Mississippi Fair
10	Commission, the Mississippi Livestock Coliseum, the Industrial
11	Showcase, the Trade Mart Building and for the purpose of paying
12	any indebtedness which may accrue for the period beginning
13	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 \$ 3,398,422.00.
14	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
15	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
16	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
17	Permanent: Full Time 9
18	Part Time 22
19	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
20	Part Time 0
21	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
22	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
23	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
24	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
25	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
26	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
27	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
28	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
29	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
30	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
31	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
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- 32 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 33 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 34
- 35 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 36
- 37 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 38
- 39 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 40
- requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 41
- 42 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 43
- 44 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 45
- 46 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 47 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 48
- 49 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 50 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 51 appropriated level.
- 52 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 53 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 54 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 55 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 56 SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
- all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions: 57
- 58 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
- positions; 59
- 60 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or
- otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, 61
- reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 62
- or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions 63
- except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 64
- 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 65

- 66 The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
- 67 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 68
- 69 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for 70
- 71 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- 72 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 73
- 74 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds to publish or 75
- 76 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- 77 The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the 78
- 79 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 80
- 81 The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 82
- 83 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 84 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- The agency shall not expend funds for staff development 85 (8)
- 86 or training services;
- The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of 87
- 88 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
- 89 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
- 90 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
- forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session. 91
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 92
- of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 93
- 94 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate
- 95 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony
- announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 96
- 97 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening
- 98 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has
- made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 99
- 100 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

- 101 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the
- 102 Mississippi State Legislature."
- 103 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 104 Mississippi Fair Commission shall maintain complete accounting and
- 105 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 106 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 107 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 108 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 109 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to
- 110 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 111 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 112 during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
- 113 **SECTION 6.** No operation, maintenance or service contracts,
- 114 agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or
- 115 catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency
- 116 for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said
- 117 contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance
- 118 with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi
- 119 Code of 1972.
- 120 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 121 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 122 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 123 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 124 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 125 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 126 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 127 and after July 1, 2004.
