House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3145

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Banking
8	and Consumer Finance, for the support of the State Department of
9	Banking and Consumer Finance, for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
11	\$ 4,432,520.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 49
16	Part Time 0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
18	Part Time 0
19	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
20	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
21	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
22	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
23	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
24	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
25	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
26	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
27	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
28	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
29	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
30	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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31 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 32 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 33 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 35 36 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 37 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 40

41 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 42 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 43 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 44 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 47 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 49 appropriated level.

50 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

54 **SECTION 3.** The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund 55 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:

56 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant57 positions;

58 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or59 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,

60 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, 61 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions 62 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 63 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 64 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
65 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
66 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;

67 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or 68 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for 69 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the 70 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology 71 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 72 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;

73 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or74 distribute any annual reports or other publications;

75 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation 76 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the 77 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 78 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;

79 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs 80 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development 81 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 82 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

83 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development84 or training services;

(9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 90 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 91 92 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 93 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 94 95 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 96 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 97 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 98 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

99 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 100 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 101 102 State Department of Banking and Consumer Finance shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the 103 104 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 105 maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of 106 107 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 108 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 109 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request 110 111 process.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 112 113 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 114 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 115 116 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 117 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 118 and after July 1, 2004. 119
