House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3157

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road
8	Construction Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
9	the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi
10	Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 \$ 138,856,185.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 46 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 47 48 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 49 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 50 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 51 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 53 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 56 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 57 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 58 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 60 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 61 62 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 63 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

- 65 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 66 appropriated level.
- 67 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 68 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 69
- 70 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 71 SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
- 72 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:
- 73 The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
- 74 positions;
- (2) 75 The agency shall not take any action to promote or
- 76 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,
- 77 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- 78 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- 79 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 80 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state 81
- 82 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 83 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or 84
- 85 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 86 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- 87 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- 88 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 89 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds to publish or 90
- 91 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- The agency shall not expend funds for public relation 92
- 93 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- 94 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 95
- 96 The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 97 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry 98
- 99 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;

- 100 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development 101 or training services;
- 102 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
 103 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
 104 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
 105 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
 106 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 107 108 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 109 110 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 111 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 112 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 113 114 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 115 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 116 117 Mississippi State Legislature."
 - SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
- SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
 Office of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and
 expend funds not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
 (\$300,000.00) out of funds received from the Mississippi
 Development Authority as reimbursement for actual expenses
 incurred by the Office of State Aid Road Construction for
 administering and providing engineering services to political

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135 subdivisions as authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code

136 of 1972, subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations

137 of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner

138 consistent with the escalation of federal funds. Any escalated

139 funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads

140 Administrative Fund, a special fund hereby created in the State

141 Treasury, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending

142 June 30, 2005.

143 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this

144 act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction is authorized to

145 reimburse Walthall County in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty

146 Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) from unobligated State Aid funds

147 allocated to Walthall County for the 2004-2007 term of office of

148 members of the board of supervisors for expenditures made by

149 Walthall County to match funds of the United States Army Corps of

Engineers for the project known as Dillon's Bridge, Bogue Chitto

151 River, Walthall County.

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152 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this

153 act, it is the intent of the Legislature that One Hundred Sixty

154 Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00) shall be expended for replacement

155 and/or rehabilitation of a certain bridge over Hatchie Creek in

156 Tippah County for providing access to a civil war battle site,

157 which bridge project shall be administered by the Office of State

158 Aid Road Construction as provided under Chapter 37 of Title 65,

159 Mississippi Code of 1972; however, such bridge shall be performed

160 according to specifications adopted and approved by the county

161 engineer and the Board of Supervisors of Tippah County.

Of the funds in Section 1, One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars

163 (\$160,000.00) shall be derived from the Mississippi Department of

164 Transportation Fund in the State Treasury.

165 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds in Section 1, Twenty Million Dollars

166 (\$20,000,000.00) shall be derived from funds deposited into the

167 Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund,

168 contingent upon passage of House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular

169 Session.

SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 170 171 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the 172 173 office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges 174 175 on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as 176 established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 177 178 expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the 179 180 State Fiscal Officer. SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 181 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 182 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 183 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 184 185 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 186

SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2004.
