AMEND by deleting lines 9 through 17 in their entirety and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

"SECTION 1. (1) Any governmental entity, individually or 3 4 jointly with any other governmental entity, may enter into 5 cooperative agreements with each other and with the Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and/or any water management 6 7 district, for the purpose of creating, improving or restoring state parks, public game and fish habitat lying or to be situated 8 9 wholly or partially within the territorial jurisdiction of the governmental entity or within the territorial jurisdiction of an 10 11 adjoining governmental entity; and any such governmental entity may use property, equipment, materials, supplies and employees of 12 13 the governmental entity for such purposes.

14 (2) For the purposes of this section, the following terms15 have the meanings ascribed to them under this subsection:

16 (a) "Governmental entity" means the board of 17 supervisors of any county and the governing authorities of any 18 municipality;

(b) "Water management district" means the Pat Harrison
Waterway District, the Pearl River Basin Development District, the
Pearl River Valley Water Management District, the Tombigbee River

22 Valley Water Management District and the Yellow Creek Watershed

23 Authority."

AMEND FURTHER by deleting the title in its entirety and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

26 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES TO ENTER INTO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH EACH 27 OTHER AND WITH THE COMMISSION ON WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS 28 29 AND/OR WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING, 30 IMPROVING OR RESTORING STATE PARKS, PUBLIC GAME AND FISH HABITAT; TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF THE PROPERTY, EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, 31 32 SUPPLIES AND EMPLOYEES OF COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES FOR SUCH 33 PURPOSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
