- 1 **AMEND** by striking Sections 1 through 5 in their entirety and 2 renumbering succeeding sections.
- 3 AMEND further by striking lines 309 through 319 in their
- 4 entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 5 "(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct or
- 6 resist by force, or violence, or threats, or in any other manner,
- 7 his lawful arrest or the lawful arrest of another person by any
- 8 state, local or federal law enforcement officer, and any person or
- 9 persons so doing shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon
- 10 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
- 11 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the county
- 12 jail not more than six (6) months, or both.
- 13 (2) (a) Any person who commits a misdemeanor or felony
- 14 offense and as a result willfully flees or attempts to elude a law
- 15 enforcement officer in an authorized law enforcement patrol
- 16 vehicle with agency insignia and other jurisdictional markings
- 17 prominently displayed on the vehicle with siren and lights
- 18 activated, and during the course of the fleeing or attempted
- 19 eluding, drives at high speed, or in any manner which demonstrates
- 20 a reckless disregard for the safety of persons or property, shall
- 21 be subject to an enhanced penalty for such offense.
