## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Any pre-need contract which is executed by 8 the decedent for his own arrangements and is fully funded 9 overrules, following the decedent's death, the conflicting wishes 10 of the decedent's next of kin, unless a compelling public interest 11 makes it impossible to comply with a decedent's directions in a 12 pre-need contract.

13 (2) The provisions of this section shall not prevent the 14 decedent's next of kin or surviving heirs at law from, at their 15 own expense, pursuing reasonable services and making reasonable 16 arrangements that do not conflict with the decedent's directions 17 in a pre-need contract.

18 (3) All contract providers shall have the right to rely on 19 the pre-need contract and perform obligations in accordance with 20 the pre-need contract. There shall be no liability for any 21 contract provider who in good faith performs his obligations 22 pursuant to the pre-need contract, provided the pre-need contract 23 is in compliance with Section 75-63-51 et seq. and any rules 24 promulgated thereunder.
