3 "SECTION 6. From and after July 1, 2004, the board of supervisors of a county shall reduce the ad valorem taxes levied 4 5 by the county in an amount equal to one-half (1/2) of the county's share of the revenue derived from the oil and gas severance tax 6 under Sections 27-25-505 and 27-25-705 as a result of off shore 7 drilling on the Mississippi Gulf Coast. From and after July 1, 8 9 2004, the governing authorities of a municipality shall reduce the ad valorem taxes levied by the municipality in an amount equal to 10 one-half (1/2) of the municipality's share of the revenue derived 11 from the oil and gas severance tax under Sections 27-25-505 and 12 27-25-705 as a result of off shore drilling on the Mississippi 13 Gulf Coast." 14

15 AMEND FURTHER, the title to conform on 13 after the semicolon by inserting the following: "TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF 16 SUPERVISORS OF A COUNTY SHALL TO REDUCE THE AD VALOREM TAXES 17 LEVIED BY THE COUNTY IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ONE-HALF (1/2) OF THE 18 COUNTY'S SHARE OF THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE OIL AND GAS 19 SEVERANCE TAX UNDER SECTIONS 27-25-505 AND 27-25-705 AS A RESULT 20 21 OF OFF SHORE DRILLING ON THE MISSISSIPPI GULF COAST AND THE 22 GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF A MUNICIPALITY SHALL REDUCE THE AD 23 VALOREM TAXES LEVIED BY THE MUNICIPALITY IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 24 ONE-HALF (1/2) OF THE MUNICIPALITY'S SHARE OF THE REVENUE DERIVED 25 FROM THE OIL AND GAS SEVERANCE TAX UNDER SECTIONS 27-25-505 AND 26 27-25-705 AS A RESULT OF OFF SHORE DRILLING ON THE MISSISSIPPI 27 GULF COAST.
