## Adopted AMENDMENT NO 2 TO COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Senate Bill No. 2859

1	AMEND by inserting the following new subsections (16) and
2	(17) after line 1119 and renumbering the succeeding subsection:
3	"(17) The State Department of Health shall issue a
4	certificate of need for the construction of a new comprehensive
5	general acute care hospital in Lee County, with not less than one
6	hundred (100) nor more than two hundred and fifty (250) acute care
7	beds. As a condition of the issuance of the certificate of need
8	under this subsection, the recipient of the certificate of need
9	must agree in writing to participate in all state and federal
10	health care reimbursement programs, including, but not limited to,
11	Medicare, Medicaid, CHAMPUS, CHIP, and to provide treatment to
12	patients who are beneficiaries of the State and School Employees
13	Health Insurance Program. This written agreement by the recipient
14	of the certificate of need shall be fully binding on any later
15	owner of the hospital, if the ownership of the hospital is
16	transferred at any time after the issuance of the certificate of
17	need. If, after the issuance of the certificate of need, the
18	hospital fails to participate in the state and federal health care
19	reimbursement programs as required under this subsection, the
20	State Department of Health shall revoke the certificate of need,
21	if it is still outstanding, and shall deny, suspend or revoke the
22	license of the hospital, at the time that the department

- 23 determines, after a hearing complying with due process, that the
- 24 hospital has failed to comply with the conditions upon which the
- 25 certificate of need was issued, as provided in this subsection and
- 26 in the written agreement by the recipient of the certificate of
- 27 need. For purposes of this subsection, the provisions of Section
- 28 41-7-193(1) requiring substantial compliance with the projection
- 29 of need as reported in the current State Health Plan are waived.
- 30 (18) The State Department of Health shall issue a
- 31 <u>certificate of need for the construction of a new acute care</u>
- 32 hospital in the City of Olive Branch in DeSoto County, not to
- exceed one hundred fifty (150) acute care beds. For purposes of
- 34 this subsection, the provisions of Section 41-7-193(1) requiring
- 35 substantial compliance with the projection of need as reported in
- 36 the current State Health Plan are waived."
- 37 **AMEND FURTHER** the title on line 6 by inserting the following
- 38 after the semicolon:
- 39 "TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL ISSUE A
- 40 CERTIFICATE OF NEED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW COMPREHENSIVE
- 41 GENERAL ACUTE CARE HOSPITAL IN LEE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE THAT, AS A
- 42 CONDITION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE CERTIFICATE OF NEED, THE
- 43 RECIPIENT OF THE CERTIFICATE OF NEED MUST AGREE IN WRITING TO
- 44 PARTICIPATE IN ALL STATE AND FEDERAL HEALTH CARE REIMBURSEMENT
- 45 PROGRAMS OR THE DEPARTMENT WILL SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE OF
- 46 THE HOSPITAL; TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL
- 47 ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF NEED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ACUTE
- 48 CARE HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF OLIVE BRANCH IN DESOTO COUNTY;"
