Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road
8	Construction Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
9	the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi
10	Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 \$ 138,856,185.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

36	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
37	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
38	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
39	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
40	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
41	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
42	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
43	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
44	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
45	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
46	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
47	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
48	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
49	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
50	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
51	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
52	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
53	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
54	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
55	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

- 56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 60 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 61 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 62 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 63 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 65 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 66 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 68 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 69 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 70 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 71 **SECTION 3.** The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
- 72 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:
- 73 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
- 74 positions;
- 75 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or
- 76 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,
- 77 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- 78 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- 79 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 80 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 81 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
- 82 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 83 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 84 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 85 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 86 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- 87 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology

- 88 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 89 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 90 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or
- 91 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- 92 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- 93 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- 94 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 95 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 96 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 97 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- 98 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 99 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 100 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
- 101 or training services;
- 102 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- 103 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
- 104 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
- 105 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
- 106 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.
- 107 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 108 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members
- 109 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate
- 110 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony
- 111 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public
- 112 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening
- 113 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has
- 114 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or
- 115 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following
- 116 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the
- 117 Mississippi State Legislature."
- 118 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 119 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete

120 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 121 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 122 123 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 124 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be 125 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 126 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 127 128 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 129 Office of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and 130 expend funds not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) out of funds received from the Mississippi 131 132 Development Authority as reimbursement for actual expenses incurred by the Office of State Aid Road Construction for 133 134 administering and providing engineering services to political 135 subdivisions as authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code 136 of 1972, subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations 137 of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. Any escalated 138 139 funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads 140 Administrative Fund, a special fund hereby created in the State 141 Treasury, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005. 142 143 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 144 act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction is authorized to reimburse Walthall County in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty 145 146 Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) from unobligated State Aid funds 147 allocated to Walthall County for the 2004-2007 term of office of members of the board of supervisors for expenditures made by 148 Walthall County to match funds of the United States Army Corps of 149 150 Engineers for the project known as Dillon's Bridge, Bogue Chitto 151 River, Walthall County.

- 152 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 153 act, it is the intent of the Legislature that One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00) shall be expended for replacement 154 155 and/or rehabilitation of a certain bridge over Hatchie Creek in 156 Tippah County for providing access to a civil war battle site, 157 which bridge project shall be administered by the Office of State 158 Aid Road Construction as provided under Chapter 37 of Title 65, Mississippi Code of 1972; however, such bridge shall be performed 159 160 according to specifications adopted and approved by the county
- Of the funds in Section 1, One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00) shall be derived from the Mississippi Department of Transportation Fund in the State Treasury.

engineer and the Board of Supervisors of Tippah County.

- SECTION 9. Of the funds in Section 1, Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) shall be derived from funds deposited into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund, contingent upon passage of House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.
- 170 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 171 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the 172 173 office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges 174 175 on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in 176 accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 177 178 expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the 179 180 State Fiscal Officer.
- SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

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warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2004.
