## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 438

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- Section 43-13-405, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8
- 9 amended as follows:
- 43-13-405. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this 10
- article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health 11
- Care Trust Fund, into which shall be deposited Two Hundred Eighty 12
- Million Dollars (\$280,000,000.00) of the funds received by the 13
- 14 State of Mississippi as a result of the tobacco settlement as of
- the end of fiscal year 1999, and all tobacco settlement 15
- 16 installment payments made in subsequent years for which the use or
- 17 purpose for expenditure is not restricted by the terms of the
- settlement, except as otherwise provided in Section 43-13-407(2) 18
- 19 and (3). All income from the investment of the funds in the
- 20 Health Care Trust Fund shall be credited to the account of the
- 21 Health Care Trust Fund. The funds in the Health Care Trust Fund
- at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General 22
- 23 Fund.
- The Health Care Trust Fund shall remain inviolate and 2.4
- 25 shall never be expended, except as provided in this article.
- Legislature shall appropriate from the Health Care Trust Fund such 26
- 27 sums as are necessary to recoup any funds lost as a result of any
- 28 of the following actions:
- The federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid 29
- 30 Services, or other agency of the federal government, is successful
- 31 in recouping tobacco settlement funds from the State of
- Mississippi; 32

- The federal share of funds for the support of the 33 (b)
- 34 Mississippi Medicaid Program is reduced directly or indirectly as
- a result of the tobacco settlement; 35
- 36 Federal funding for any other program is reduced as
- a result of the tobacco settlement; or 37
- 38 (d) Tobacco cessation programs are mandated by the
- 39 federal government or court order.
- 40 This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2005.
- 41 Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 42
- 43 43-13-407. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this
- article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health 44
- Care Expendable Fund, into which shall be transferred from the 45
- Health Care Trust Fund the following sums: 46
- 47 In fiscal year 2000, Fifty Million Dollars
- (\$50,000,000.00); 48
- In fiscal year 2001, Fifty-five Million Dollars 49
- (\$55,000,000.00); 50
- 51 (C) In fiscal year 2002, Sixty Million Five Hundred
- Thousand Dollars (\$60,500,000.00); 52
- In fiscal year 2003, Sixty-six Million Five Hundred 53 (d)
- Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$66,550,000.00); 54
- 55 In fiscal year 2004 and each subsequent fiscal
- 56 year, a sum equal to the average annual amount of the income from
- 57 the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund since
- July 1, 1999. 58
- In any fiscal year in which interest and dividends from 59
- 60 the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund are not
- sufficient to fund the full amount of the annual transfer into the 61
- 62 Health Care Expendable Fund as required in subsection (1) of this
- section, the State Treasurer shall transfer from tobacco 63
- 64 settlement installment payments an amount that is sufficient to
- fully fund the amount of the annual transfer. 65
- On March 6, 2002, the State Treasurer shall 66 (a)
- 67 transfer the sum of Eighty-seven Million Dollars (\$87,000,000.00)

68 from the Health Care Trust Fund into the Health Care Expendable

69 In addition, at the time the State of Mississippi receives

the 2002 calendar year tobacco settlement installment payment, the 70

71 State Treasurer shall deposit the full amount of that installment

payment into the Health Care Expendable Fund, and at the time the 72

73 State of Mississippi receives the 2003 calendar year tobacco

74 settlement installment payment, the State Treasurer shall deposit

75 the full amount of that installment payment into the Health Care

76 Expendable Fund, and at the time the State of Mississippi receives

the 2004 calendar year tobacco settlement installment payment, the

State Treasurer shall deposit the full amount of that installment

payment into the Health Care Expendable Fund. 79

- 80 If during any fiscal year after March 6, 2002, the (b)
- general fund revenues received by the state exceed the general 81
- 82 fund revenues received during the previous fiscal year by more
- 83 than five percent (5%), the Legislature shall repay to the Health
- Care Trust Fund one-third (1/3) of the amount of the general fund 84
- 85 revenues that exceed the five percent (5%) growth in general fund
- The repayment required by this paragraph shall continue 86 revenues.
- in each fiscal year in which there is more than five percent (5%) 87
- growth in general fund revenues, until the full amount of the 88
- 89 funds that were transferred and deposited into the Health Care
- 90 Expendable Fund under the provisions of paragraph (a) of this
- 91 subsection have been repaid to the Health Care Trust Fund.
- 92 All income from the investment of the funds in the
- Health Care Expendable Fund shall be credited to the account of 93
- 94 the Health Care Expendable Fund. Any funds in the Health Care
- 95 Expendable Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into
- 96 the State General Fund.
- 97 The funds in the Health Care Expendable Fund shall be
- available for expenditure under specific appropriation by the 98
- 99 Legislature beginning in fiscal year 2000, and shall be expended
- 100 exclusively for health care purposes.
- Subsections (1), (2), (4) and (5) of this section shall 101
- stand repealed on July 1, 2005. 102

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103 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 104 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 43-13-405 AND 43-13-407, MISSISSIPPI
- 2 CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE AUTOMATIC REPEALERS ON STATUTES
- CREATING THE TOBACCO LITIGATION HEALTH CARE PRINCIPAL FUND AND
- 4 HEALTH CARE EXPENDABLE FUND, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE ENTIRE 2004
- TOBACCO LITIGATION INSTALLMENT PAYMENT SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE
- HEALTH CARE EXPENDABLE FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
