Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 667

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37-39-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-39-23. The school boards of all public school districts
- may, in their discretion, * * * enter into an agreement, not 8
- inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter, to act jointly 9
- 10 in the purchase of maintenance, operational and scholastic
- 11 services, supplies and materials and equipment.
- It is the purpose of this section to enable the school 12
- 13 systems * * * to achieve economies of scale through increased
- 14 purchasing power to the end that the education tax revenues be
- utilized efficiently. 15
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 16
- and after July 1, 2004. 17

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-39-23, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO MAKE JOINT PURCHASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2
