## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 781

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A privately-operated correctional facility shall
- 7 not procure goods, to be used by inmates housed in Mississippi
- 8 facilities, that have been manufactured using inmates in a
- 9 correctional system of another state if Mississippi Prison
- 10 Industries is presently manufacturing the same goods using
- 11 Mississippi inmates, unless the cost of the goods and services can
- 12 be procured at a price that is at least thirty percent (30%) less
- 13 than the cost of the same goods and services provided by
- 14 Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 2004; and shall stand repealed from and after
- 17 July 1, 2005.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PRIVATELY-OPERATED CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES
- 2 FROM IMPORTING GOODS MANUFACTURED USING INMATE LABOR OF ANOTHER
- 3 STATE INTO THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI TO BE USED BY INMATES HOUSED
- 4 IN INSTATE FACILITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
