Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1594

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The following highways, roads and streets 11 located in the State of Mississippi are hereby designated as an 12 official Mississippi scenic byway to be known as the "Lower 13 Mississippi Historic Scenic Byway," pursuant to Section 65-41-1 et 14 seq.:

15 Begin on U.S. Highway 61 at the Warren/Issaquena County 16 line and travel south along U.S. Highway 61 in Warren County, to Business 61 (North Washington Street); travel 17 north on Washington Street to downtown Vicksburg. 18 19 Continue traveling on Washington Street as it merges into Warrington Road; travel Warrington Road to U.S. 20 Highway 61; continue on U.S. Highway 61 South to 21 22 Claiborne County.

23 Upon entering Claiborne County, continue traveling south 24 on U.S. Highway 61. At Grand Gulf Road, travel west to 25 Grand Gulf Military Park. Turn on Grand Gulf Road to U.S. Highway 61. Travel south on U.S. Highway 61 to 26 Port Gibson. U.S. Highway 61 at Port Gibson is also 27 known as "Church Street." At the intersection of Church 28 29 Street and Orange Street, travel west on Orange Street, 30 past the Claiborne County Courthouse to Market Street. Travel south on Market Street four (4) blocks, past 31 32 Mississippi Cultural Crossroads, Matt Ross Administrative Building, Harriette Pearson Memorial 33 Library and Meyer Marx Building until you reach Carroll 34 Return to Church Street and travel south on 35 Street.

U.S. Highway 61 to Jefferson County. This corridor also
includes Rodney Road, which is Carroll Street (west of
Market Street). Travel west on Rodney Road, past the
Shaifer House and grounds; travel past the Ruins of
Windsor where Rodney Road merges into Highway 552.
Travel past Alcorn State University on Highway 552 back
to U.S. Highway 61.

Travel south on U.S. Highway 61 until you reach Adams 43 44 County and continue on U.S. Highway 61 through the City of Natchez to U.S. Highway 61/84 Interchange; travel 45 46 west on U.S. Highway 84 to the Natchez Intermodal Center at the Mississippi River Bridge. Return to U.S. Highway 47 61/84 interchange and travel south on U.S. Highway 61 48 49 through the southern portion of Natchez to Wilkinson Traveling south on U.S. Highway 61 through 50 County. 51 Woodville to the Louisiana state line. This terminates the Lower Mississippi Historic Byway. 52

53 (2) Outdoor advertising as identified in the Lower 54 Mississippi Historic Byway Corridor Management Plan shall be allowed on U.S. Highway 61 and U.S. Highway 84 within the 55 56 corporate limits of the impacted municipalities along the byway 57 subject to the zoning and signage statutes and ordinances of the 58 state and the impacted municipalities. Outdoor advertising 59 outside of a municipality's corporate limit must be in compliance 60 with applicable local, state and federal guidelines.

61 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The following highways, roads or streets 62 located in the State of Mississippi are hereby designated as an 63 official Mississippi Scenic Byway to be known as the "Mississippi 64 Delta Great River Road Scenic Byway," pursuant to Sections 65-41-1 65 et seq.:

Begin on Mississippi Highway 1 at the intersection with
U.S. Highway 49 near Lula, Mississippi, and travel south
along Mississippi Highway 1. Continue south along
Mississippi Highway 1 through Coahoma County, Bolivar
County, Washington County, east along Mississippi

H. B. 1594 PAGE 2 Highway 1 at Sharkey County and then south along Mississippi Highway 1 at Issaquena County. Continue on Mississippi Highway 1 south to the intersection of U.S. Highway 61 at Mississippi Highway 1 at Onward; continue south along U.S. Highway 61 to the Issaquena/Warren County line. This terminates the "Mississippi Delta Great River Road Scenic Byway."

(2) Outdoor advertising as identified in the Mississippi 78 79 Delta Great River Road Scenic Byway Corridor Management Plan shall be allowed on Mississippi Highway 1 and U.S. Highway 61 within the 80 81 corporate limits of the impacted municipalities along the byway subject to the zoning and signage statutes and ordinances of the 82 state and the impacted municipalities. Outdoor advertising 83 84 outside of a municipality's corporate limit must be in compliance 85 with applicable local, state and federal guidelines.

86 SECTION 3. The following highways, roads or streets located 87 in the State of Mississippi are hereby designated as an official 88 Mississippi Scenic Byway to be known as the "Grand Gulf-Raymond 89 Scenic Byway, " pursuant to Section 65-41-1 et seq.: 90 Beginning at the Grand Gulf Military Monument on 91 the Mississippi River then east along the historic Back Grand Gulf Road to Frasier Road, following east 92 93 along Frasier Road to Y-Camp Road, following east 94 along Y-Camp Road to Ingleside-Karnac Ferry Road 95 through the community of Ingleside to Highway 61, then the route continues 1/2 mile north of Highway 96 97 61, eastward along Willows Road to the Community of Willows, then northeastward along the Old Port 98 Gibson Road terminating at the Raymond Military Park 99 100 at the City of Raymond. 101 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from

102 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE LOWER MISSISSIPPI HISTORIC BYWAY AS 2 AN OFFICIAL MISSISSIPPI SCENIC BYWAY PURSUANT TO THE MISSISSIPPI 3 SCENIC BYWAY PROGRAM; TO DESIGNATE THE MISSISSIPPI DELTA GREAT 4 RIVER ROAD SCENIC BYWAY AS AN OFFICIAL MISSISSIPPI SCENIC BYWAY 5 PURSUANT TO THE MISSISSIPPI SCENIC BYWAY PROGRAM; TO DESIGNATE THE 6 GRAND GULF-RAYMOND SCENIC BYWAY AS AN OFFICIAL MISSISSIPPI SCENIC 7 BYWAY PURSUANT TO THE MISSISSIPPI SCENIC BYWAY PROGRAM; AND FOR 8 RELATED PURPOSES.
