Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1715

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 7 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of 8 Optometry, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending 9 10 June 30, 2005.....\$ 76,820.00. 11 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Board of Optometry shall maintain complete accounting and 12 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 13 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 14 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 15 16 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 17 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to 18 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 19 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 20 during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
