Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1726

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12	SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
14	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying
15	salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and the daily expense
16	allowance of the members of the Legislature for the Regular
17	Session of 2005 and providing contingent funds for the House of
18	Representatives and Senate for the fiscal year beginning
19	July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:
20	For salaries, mileage, insurance,
21	matching funds and daily
22	expense allowance of members
23	of the House of Representatives \$2,931,721.00
24	For Contingent Fund for the
25	House of Representatives \$4,307,760.00
26	Out of the above amount appropriated for the Contingent Fund
27	for the House of Representatives, not more than Fifteen Thousand
28	Dollars (\$15,000.00) shall be expended for defraying the expenses
29	of and for the use of the members of the Mississippi Commission on
30	Interstate Cooperation, as created under Section 5-5-1 et seq.,
31	Mississippi Code of 1972.
32	For salaries, mileage, insurance,
33	matching funds and daily
34	expense allowance of members
35	of the Senate\$1,316,792.00
36	For Contingent Fund for the Senate \$3,446,759.00

37	Out of the above amount appropriated for the Contingent Fund
38	for the Senate, not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)
39	shall be expended for defraying the expenses of and for the use of
40	the members of the Mississippi Commission on Interstate
41	Cooperation, as created under Section 5-5-1 et seq., Mississippi
42	Code of 1972.
43	For the joint legislative operations of the House of
44	Representatives and the Senate \$1,375,868.00
45	For the expenses of the Joint Legislative
46	Budget Committee\$2,635,147.00
47	For the expenses of the Joint Legislative

55	The Joint Legislative Reapportionment Committee shall
56	prepare, publish and provide semiannual reports to each member of
57	the Legislature and such reports shall provide a line-by-line
58	detailed accounting of all receipts and expenditures of any and
59	all monies appropriated by the Legislature to the Joint
60	Legislative Reapportionment Committee. Any meetings of the Joint
61	Legislative Reapportionment Committee shall be held in state
62	offices or at publicly owned facilities.
63	SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be
64	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
65	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying
66	the monthly expense allowance of the members of the Legislature,
67	as provided in Section 5-1-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the
68	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005, as
69	follows:
70	For the House of Representatives\$2,291,027.00.
71	For the Senate\$ 994,099.00.

72	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
73	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
74	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying
75	the state's share of various assessments for the fiscal year
76	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
77	\$ 280,710.00.
78	Of the funds authorized in this section, the following
79	distribution shall be made:
80	Southern States Energy Board\$ 27,288.00
81	Southern Growth Policies Agreement\$ 22,842.00
82	Interstate Cooperation\$ 180,717.00

86	SECTION 4. The Legislature shall have the authority to
87	escalate its budget and expend funds from the Legislative
88	Extraordinary Session Expense Revolving Fund, as authorized in
89	Section 5-1-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, in accordance with rules
90	and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in
91	a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. The
92	authority granted in this section is provided for the purpose of
93	paying the expenses of the members of the Legislature incurred
94	during any Extraordinary Session of the Legislature occurring
95	during the period beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
96	June 30, 2005.
97	SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
98	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
99	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
100	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
101	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
102	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
103	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
104	and after July 1, 2004.
