Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1734

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Governor's Office
10	- Division of Medicaid for the purpose of providing medical
11	assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law and defraying the
12	expenses of the administration of such law, as provided in Section
13	43-13-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year
14	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
15	\$ 246,855,284.00.
16	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
17	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
18	Treasury to the credit of the Medical Care Fund created by Section
19	43-13-143, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of providing
20	medical assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law for the
21	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
22	\$ 166,190,140.00.
23	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
24	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
25	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office
26	- Division of Medicaid which is comprised of special source funds
27	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
28	purpose of providing medical assistance under the Mississippi
29	Medicaid Law and defraying the expenses of the administration of
30	such law, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
31	June 30, 2005 \$ 2,140,082,972.00.

32	Prior period recovery of funds may be maintained and expended
33	by the division when the recovery is received or finalized.
34	SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
35	Sections 1, 2 and 3, not more than the amounts set forth below

58	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
59	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
60	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
61	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
62	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
63	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
64	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
65	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
66	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

67 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

68 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

- 69 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 70 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- 71 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 72 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 73 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 74 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 75 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
- 76 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 77 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 78 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 79 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 81 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 82 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 83 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 84 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 85 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 86 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 87 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 88 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 90 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 91 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 92 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 93 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 94 Governor's Office Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete
- 95 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 96 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 97 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 98 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 99 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
- 100 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

101 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 102 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

103 SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance

104 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 105

106 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 107

108 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

109 performance measures provided below:

agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 120

Committee for Fiscal Year 2006. 121

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 122

123 Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid may authorize

124 increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts

125 not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount

of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 126

127 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar

128 amount.

129 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

130 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 131

132 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 133

134 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 135 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 136 and after July 1, 2004.
