

Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1737

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters
9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board
10 of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning
11 July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 30,800.00.

12 **SECTION 2.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
13 State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete
14 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
15 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
16 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
17 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
18 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
19 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
20 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
21 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

22 **SECTION 3.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
23 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
24 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
25 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
26 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
27 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

28 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
29 and after July 1, 2004.
