Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1738

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and
8	Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the
9	administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the
10	provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972,
11	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending
12	June 30, 2005\$ 701,182.00.
13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
15	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and
16	Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source
17	funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for
18	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the
19	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
20	\$ 3,168,455.00.
21	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
22	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
23	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
24	expenditure:

45	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
46	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
47	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
48	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
49	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
50	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
51	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
52	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
53	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
54	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
55	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
56	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
57	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
58	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
59	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
60	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
61	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
62	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
63	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
64	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

- 65 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 66 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 67
- 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 69
- 70 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 71 The
- 72 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 73 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 74 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 75 appropriated level.
- 76 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 77
- 78 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 80 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall maintain 81
- 82 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 83 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 84
- maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of 85
- 86 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 87 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 88 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 89 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request
- 90 process.
- SECTION 5. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission 91
- is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale 92
- 93 of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment
- 94 shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to
- the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall 95
- 96 be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.
- 97 SECTION 6. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission
- is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds 98
- derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et 99

100 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in

101 accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq.,

102 Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to
escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed
Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance
with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of

109 federal funds.

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110 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed 111 Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose 112 of funding a Beaver Control Cost Share program. The Mississippi 113 114 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall promulgate rules and 115 regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on a fund matching basis with the county unit of government. Funds 116 117 not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to 118 another county during the fiscal year. Only those funds 119 specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share

program shall be used in any such program.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

127 **SECTION 10.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 128 and after July 1, 2004.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005.
