Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1739

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal			
17	year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005

- 79 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
- 80 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the
- 81 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with
- the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 82
- 83 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the
- 84 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of

- SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 86
- 87 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for

- Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives 152
- 153 and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in
- 154 House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the
- preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties. 155
- 156 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 157 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept,
- 158 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand
- 159 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to
- 160 the credit of the New Capitol Repair and Renovation Fund created
- in Section 27-19-56.69 (8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the 161
- 162 purpose of paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New
- Capitol, in accordance with rules and regulations of the 163
- 164 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 165 with the escalation of federal funds.
- SECTION 11. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 166
- 167 this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00)is
- 168 provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating
- Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only 169
- 170 President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 171 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 172 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 173 174 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 175 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 176 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 177 178 and after July 1, 2004.
