Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1740

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for

45	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal				
46	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005

48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the				
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the				
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall				
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all				
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this				
53	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure				
54	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual				
55	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal				
56	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.				
57	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal				
58	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency				
59	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this

         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

- 83 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

- 96 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 97 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars
- appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans 98
- 99 and Grants, "designated for the "Challenge Program, "specific

amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts 100 101 Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse 102 103 into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature. 104 105 Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit 106 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the 107 108 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 109 110 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant. 111 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 112 Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate 113 114 its budget and expend funds from any source available not to 115 exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), that may become available to the commission in accordance with the rules 116 117 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 118 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 119 120 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 121

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
