Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1744

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi River
8	Parkway Commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
9	the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and
LO	ending June 30, 2005\$ 25,488.00.
L1	SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
L2	Mississippi River Parkway Commission shall maintain complete
L3	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
L4	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
L5	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
L6	Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
L7	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be
L8	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
L9	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
20	provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.
21	SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
22	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
23	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
24	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
25	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
26	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
27	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
28	and after July 1, 2004.
