Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1857

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 (1) The governing authorities of the City of SECTION 1. 7 Greenwood, in their discretion, may set aside, appropriate and expend, out of any available funds of the municipality, a sum not 8 to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in any fiscal year 9 and, in addition, may provide in-kind services, including the use 10 11 of county employees, equipment and supplies, for the purpose of 12 cleaning and maintaining the Cemetery of Good Shepherd and the 13 Magnolia Cemetery.

14 (2) In addition to the authority granted under subsection 15 (1) of this section, the governing authorities of the City of 16 Greenwood, in their discretion, may use any person who has been 17 convicted of a nonviolent offense and who is serving all or any 18 part of his sentence in the municipal jail for the purpose of 19 cleaning and maintaining the Cemetery of Good Shepherd and the 20 Magnolia Cemetery.

(3) The City of Greenwood, its employees and agents shall not be liable for any damage caused to any headstone, grave site, fence or other appurtenance of the Cemetery of Good Shepherd or the Magnolia Cemetery.

(4) This act shall stand repealed from and after July 1,26 2007.

27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 28 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
