COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

**House Bill No. 16**

1       **Amend by inserting the following after line 40 and**  
2 **renumbering any succeeding sections:**

3       The Department of Finance and Administration shall prepare or have  
4       prepared a distinctive plaque, to be placed in a prominent place  
5       within the Robert G. Clark, Jr., Building, which states the  
6       background, accomplishments and service to the state of the  
7       Honorable Robert G. Clark, Jr.

8       **SECTION 2.** The new justice building undergoing construction  
9       on the effective date of this act and sitting next to the Carroll  
10       Gartin Justice Building at the corner of West and High Streets in  
11       Jackson, Mississippi, shall also be named and known as the Carroll  
12       Gartin Justice Building upon the demolition of its predecessor.  
13       The Department of Finance and Administration shall prepare or have  
14       prepared a distinctive plaque, to be placed in a prominent place  
15       within the Carroll Gartin Justice Building, which states the  
16       background, accomplishments and service to the state of the  
17       Honorable Carroll Gartin. Carroll Gartin died while serving his  
18       third term as Lieutenant Governor of the State of Mississippi and  
19       had spent many years of his adult life in public service,  
20       including municipal judge, wartime combat army officer, two-term  
21       mayor and three-term Lieutenant Governor.

22       **FURTHER, amend the title by inserting the following after the**  
23 **semicolon on line 2:**

24       TO PROVIDE THAT THE NEW JUSTICE BUILDING UNDERGOING CONSTRUCTION  
25       AT THE CORNER OF WEST AND HIGH STREETS SHALL BE NAMED THE CARROLL  
26       GARTIN JUSTICE BUILDING UPON THE DEMOLITION OF ITS PREDECESSOR;
