Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 727

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 7 "Human Cloning Prohibition Act."
- 8 **SECTION 2.** The following words and phrases shall have the
- 9 meanings ascribed herein, unless the context clearly indicates
- 10 otherwise:
- 11 (a) "Human Cloning" means human asexual reproduction
- 12 accomplished by introducing the nuclear material of a human
- 13 somatic cell into a fertilized or unfertilized oocyte whose
- 14 nucleus has been removed or inactivated to produce a living
- 15 organism (at any stage of development) with a human or
- 16 predominantly human genetic constitution;
- 17 (b) "Human somatic cell" means a diploid cell (having a
- 18 complete set of chromosomes) obtained or derived from a living or
- 19 deceased human body at any stage of development;
- 20 (c) "Nuclear transplantation" means transferring the
- 21 nucleus of a human somatic cell into an oocyte from which the
- 22 nucleus or all chromosomes have been or will be removed or
- 23 rendered inert;

- 24 (d) "Nucleus" means the cell structure that houses the 25 chromosomes and thus the genes; and
- (e) "Oocyte" means the female germ cell, the egg.
- 27 **SECTION 3.** It shall be unlawful for any person or entity,
- 28 public or private, to:
- 29 (a) Perform or attempt to perform human cloning;
- 30 (b) Participate in an attempt to perform human cloning;
- 31 (c) Transfer or receive the product of human cloning;
- 32 and
- 33 (d) Transfer or receive, in whole or in part, any
- 34 oocyte, embryo, fetus or human somatic cell for the purpose of
- 35 human cloning.
- 36 **SECTION 4.** Nothing in this act shall restrict areas of
- 37 scientific research not specifically prohibited by this act,
- 38 including research in the use of nuclear transfer or other cloning
- 39 techniques to produce molecules, DNA, cells other than human
- 40 embryos, tissues, organs, plants or animals other than humans.
- 41 **SECTION 5.** (1) Any person or entity that knowingly or
- 42 recklessly violates this act shall be guilty of a felony and upon
- 43 conviction shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 44 (\$5,000.00) or imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for not more
- 45 than five (5) years, or both, and shall forfeit any licenses
- 46 issued by the state, medical, legal or otherwise.
- 47 (2) Any person or entity that violates any provision of this
- 48 act and derives a pecuniary gain from such violation shall be
- 49 fined One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or twice the amount of
- 50 gross gain, or any amount intermediate between the foregoing at
- 51 the discretion of the court.
- 52 **SECTION 6.** If any one or more provision, section,
- 53 subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this act or the
- 54 application thereof to any person or circumstance is found to be
- 55 unconstitutional, the same is hereby declared to be severable and

- 56 the balance of this act shall remain effective notwithstanding
- 57 such unconstitutionality. The Legislature hereby declares that it
- 58 would have passed this act and each provision, section,
- 59 subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word thereof, irrespective
- of the fact that any one or more provision, section, subsection,
- 61 sentence, clause, phrase or word be declared unconstitutional.
- 62 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 63 and after July 1, 2004, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 64 June 30, 2004.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO CREATE THE HUMAN CLONING PROHIBITION ACT; TO DEFINE
- 2 CERTAIN TERMS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF HUMAN
- 3 CLONING; TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR
- 4 VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
