## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The following highways, roads and streets 11 located in the State of Mississippi are hereby designated as an 12 official Mississippi scenic byway to be known as the "Lower 13 Mississippi Historic Scenic Byway," pursuant to Section 65-41-1 et 14 seq.:

15 Begin on U.S. Highway 61 at the Warren/Issaquena County line and travel south along U.S. Highway 61 in Warren 16 County, to Business 61 (North Washington Street); travel 17 north on Washington Street to downtown Vicksburg. 18 19 Continue traveling on Washington Street as it merges 20 into Warrington Road; travel Warrington Road to U.S. Highway 61; continue on U.S. Highway 61 South to 21 22 Claiborne County. 23 Upon entering Claiborne County, continue traveling south on U.S. Highway 61. At Grand Gulf Road, travel west to 24 25 Grand Gulf Military Park. Turn on Grand Gulf Road to U.S. Highway 61. Travel south on U.S. Highway 61 to 26 27 Port Gibson. U.S. Highway 61 at Port Gibson is also 28 known as "Church Street." At the intersection of Church

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Street and Orange Street, travel west on Orange Street, 29 30 past the Claiborne County Courthouse to Market Street. Travel south on Market Street four (4) blocks, past 31 32 Mississippi Cultural Crossroads, Matt Ross 33 Administrative Building, Harriette Pearson Memorial 34 Library and Meyer Marx Building until you reach Carroll 35 Return to Church Street and travel south on Street. 36 U.S. Highway 61 to Jefferson County. This corridor also 37 includes Rodney Road, which is Carroll Street (west of Market Street). Travel west on Rodney Road, past the 38 39 Shaifer House and grounds; travel past the Ruins of Windsor where Rodney Road merges into Highway 552. 40 41 Travel past Alcorn State University on Highway 552 back 42 to U.S. Highway 61.

43 Travel south on U.S. Highway 61 until you reach Adams 44 County and continue on U.S. Highway 61 through the City of Natchez to U.S. Highway 61/84 Interchange; travel 45 46 west on U.S. Highway 84 to the Natchez Intermodal Center 47 at the Mississippi River Bridge. Return to U.S. Highway 48 61/84 interchange and travel south on U.S. Highway 61 49 through the southern portion of Natchez to Wilkinson 50 County. Traveling south on U.S. Highway 61 through 51 Woodville to the Louisiana state line. This terminates 52 the Lower Mississippi Historic Byway.

53 (2) Outdoor advertising as identified in the Lower Mississippi Historic Byway Corridor Management Plan shall be 54 55 allowed on U.S. Highway 61 and U.S. Highway 84 within the corporate limits of the impacted municipalities along the byway 56 57 subject to the zoning and signage statutes and ordinances of the 58 state and the impacted municipalities. Outdoor advertising 59 outside of a municipality's corporate limit must be in compliance 60 with applicable local, state and federal guidelines.

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61 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The following highways, roads or streets 62 located in the State of Mississippi are hereby designated as an 63 official Mississippi Scenic Byway to be known as the "Mississippi 64 Delta Great River Road Scenic Byway," pursuant to Sections 65-41-1 65 et seq.:

66 Begin on Mississippi Highway 1 at the intersection with 67 U.S. Highway 49 near Lula, Mississippi, and travel south 68 along Mississippi Highway 1. Continue south along 69 Mississippi Highway 1 through Coahoma County, Bolivar 70 County, Washington County, east along Mississippi 71 Highway 1 at Sharkey County and then south along 72 Mississippi Highway 1 at Issaquena County. Continue on 73 Mississippi Highway 1 south to the intersection of U.S. Highway 61 at Mississippi Highway 1 at Onward; continue 74 75 south along U.S. Highway 61 to the Issaquena/Warren 76 County line. This terminates the "Mississippi Delta 77 Great River Road Scenic Byway."

78 (2) Outdoor advertising as identified in the Mississippi 79 Delta Great River Road Scenic Byway Corridor Management Plan shall 80 be allowed on Mississippi Highway 1 and U.S. Highway 61 within the corporate limits of the impacted municipalities along the byway 81 82 subject to the zoning and signage statutes and ordinances of the state and the impacted municipalities. Outdoor advertising 83 outside of a municipality's corporate limit must be in compliance 84 85 with applicable local, state and federal guidelines.

86 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The following highways, roads or streets located 87 in the State of Mississippi are hereby designated as an official 88 Mississippi Scenic Byway to be known as the "Grand Gulf-Raymond 89 Scenic Byway," pursuant to Section 65-41-1 et seq.: 90 Beginning at the Grand Gulf Military Monument on

91 the Mississippi River then east along the historic92 Back Grand Gulf Road to Frasier Road, following east

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along Frasier Road to Y-Camp Road, following east 93 along Y-Camp Road to Ingleside-Karnac Ferry Road 94 through the community of Ingleside to Highway 61, 95 96 then the route continues 1/2 mile north of Highway 97 61, eastward along Willows Road to the Community of Willows, then northeastward along the Old Port 98 99 Gibson Road terminating at the Raymond Military Park at the City of Raymond. 100 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 101 102 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
