32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal 45 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 46 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 47 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 49 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 51 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53 54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

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allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 68 Pat Harrison Waterway District shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 69 70 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 71 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 72 73 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to 74 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 75 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 76 during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

SECTION 4. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

84 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 85 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 86 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

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87 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88 and after July 1, 2004.
